- 4. Be a good communicator with adults as well as children
- 5. Be self-motivated, able to work without constant supervision, and part of a team
- 6. Have a positive attitude, punctuality, and good attendance
- 7. Assist in at least five different classrooms during the school year
- 8. Provide own transportation to the field experience site
